Minutes

The minutes from June 2017 were approved with minor changes.

Agenda Items

1. Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) Update

- On the topic of the Opioid Task Force the IDPH director, Nirav Shah, has been asked to come to the next Neonatal Abstinence Syndrome (NAS) meeting.
- Dr. Locher's presentation from the previous meeting has been sent over to Director Shah.
- SMM is underway and IDPH will continue to work on it, still more to come.

2. Illinois Perinatal Quality Collaborative (ILPQC) Update

- Ann Borders, Patti Lee King, and Dan Weiss from the ILPQC covered their updates.
- December 19th is their 5th Annual Conference.
 - o Went over the agenda for the upcoming annual conference.
 - o They are accepting abstracts and papers for the annual meeting.
 - o Doing awards for excellence for the poster session abstracts.
 - o Asked for recommendations or comments for the conference.
 - o The SQC committee was curious about: the poster submissions, the neonatal breakout sessions.
 - o Went over the maternal hypertension data and the yearly graph: time to treatment, patient education, patient follow-up, and debriefing
 - o Talked about the awards for the IL Maternal Hypertension Hospital Teams. Awarding gold, silver, and bronze based on levels that the hospitals have reached.
 - o Asked the committee for help with the design. Recommended that they wanted diversity on the logo. Think that the picture design is a little busy.
 - o Sending the network administrators a list of hospitals that are in the bottom quartile and hospitals that have not yet achieved the 80% of time to treatment.
 - o Looked at maintaining their hypertension initiatives sustainability in 2018
- Golden Hour
 - o Went over the data and graphs on: communication practices, delivery room practices, family engagement, admission practices-temperature and IV glucose.
 - o They are doing awards for quality improvement for the golden hour initiative.
- 2018 Initiatives:
 - o Mothers and Newborns Affected by Opioids (MNO)
 - ILPQC has received a grant from CDC and IDPH
 - Working with IDPH, Opioid Task Force, and the NAS Advisory Committee
 - Participating in collaborative of state PQC's on implementation of ACOG AIM OB Care for Women and Opioid Use Disorder Bundle
 - Plan to launch in 2018 with their neo and OB teams.
 - Seek to (1) improve screening of pregnant women and linkage to care during and after pregnancy and to (2) improve and standardize care of newborns affected by NAS.
 - Trying to align MNO and the State of Illinois' Opioid Action Plan.
 - Went over their timeline for MNO launch.
 - Planning to launch with the teams by April 2018

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- o Immediate Postpartum LARC
 - Move to make these two initiatives MNO/IPLARC to be set forth as the next to be the initiatives for 2018/2019. 1st Deborah Rosenberg, 2nd Jean Goodman, Unanimous Approval.
 - Received grant from J.B. and M.K. Pritzker Foundation
 - Ann Borders to send a couple bullets for MNO and IPLARC for PAC meeting.

3. New Business

- M&M Process and Quality
 - o Motion to create a sub-committee for 1st Cindy Mitchel 2nd Rita Brennan, Unanimous Approval

- Improving uptake for flu and TDAP shots
 - o IDPH wanted to talk to the committee about the lack of data and information about flu and women throughout Illinois.
 - o IDPH asked for ideas or recommendations on how to approach the response to the article and if patients will ask about the flu vaccine and pregnancy.
 - o Recommended for ACOG to put out some language on the issue.
 - o Send it out to health departments and hospitals to send it out to their providers.
 - o Bring it up at the M&M meetings at individual hospitals.
