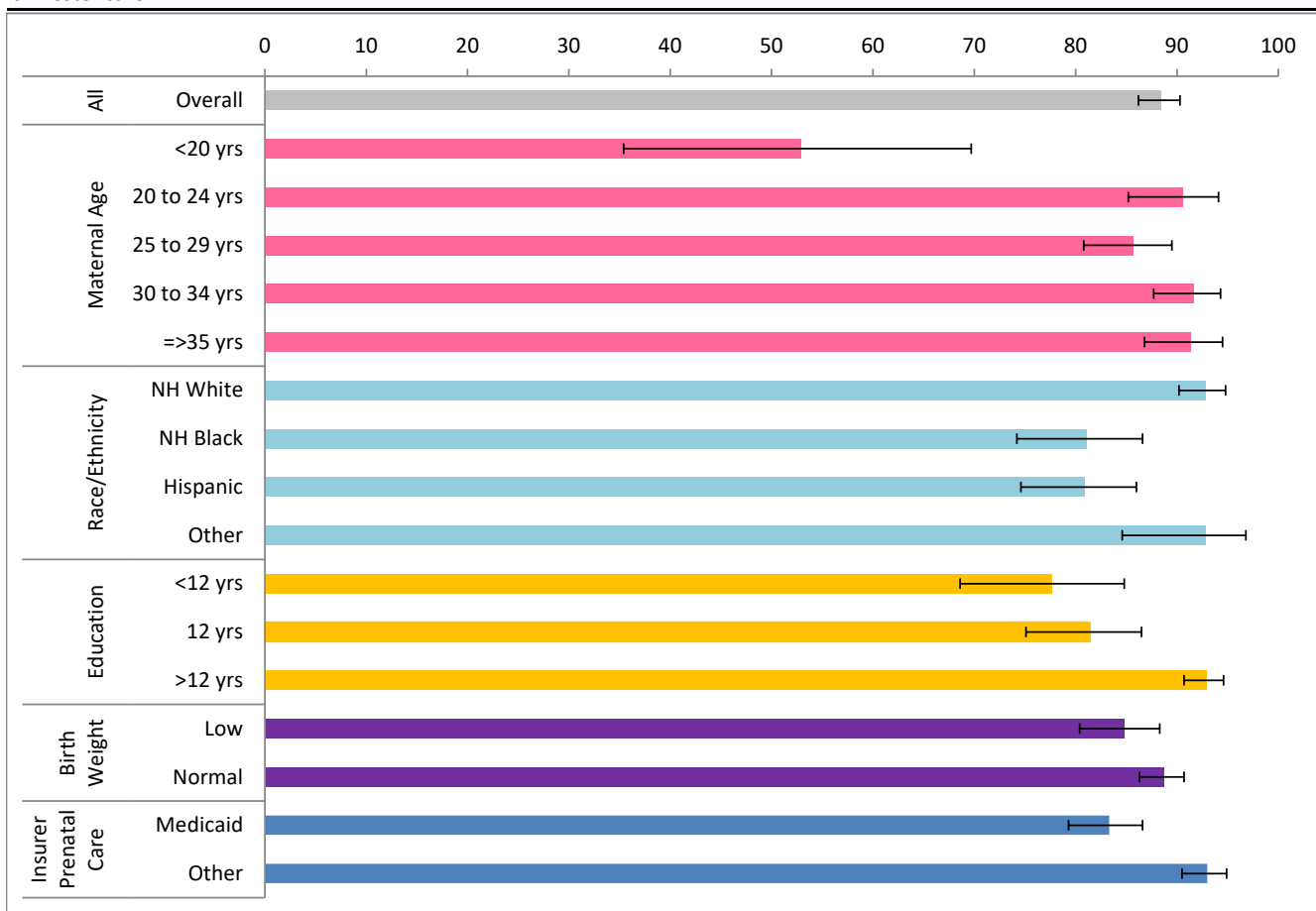


Prenatal Care
