- Justin DeWitt opened the floor for public comment; Gerald Tienstra responded.
- Gerald Tienstra- Thanked the Veterans of Illinois for their service.
- Justin DeWitt discussed code revisions to the Illinois Plumbing License Law including lead and water testing in schools; IDPH is providing guidance to schools and labs on mitigating lead risks.
- Stephanie Bennett discussed lead and water testing in schools and daycare centers. January 01, 2018 testing will be implemented and should be completed by the end of March 2018.
- Justin DeWitt discussed lead service lines and working with the local municipalities.
- Justin DeWitt discussed upcoming code revisions and that IDPH will provide a draft of code changes to the PCAC board members for review.
- Brian Cox discussed dialysis clinics; IDPH's role for inspections of dialysis clinics; partnering with CDC; requiring separation of waste water supply.
- Board discusses the hybrid waterless urinal presented by SLOAN.

Product Review

- Daniel Gleiberman with SLOAN presented on hybrid waterless urinals that are compliant with the 2014 Illinois Plumbing Code.
