<p>Health Equity in the SHIP</p>	<p><u>Department of Public Health - Andrea Palmer</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Title V Block Grant <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Preventative/health of mothers ○ Needs assessed every 5 years ○ MCH sets priorities ○ Establishes action plan/national performance measures ○ Centered around health equities ○ Mainly focuses on infant mortality <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ 2010 – 2014 Data <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - State of Illinois has 6.4 infant deaths per 1000 live births - White 4.4/1000, Black 12.2/1000, Hispanic 5.8/1000, Asian/Pacific Islander 4.1/1000 ○ Health equity within grant agreements <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Collect data by race and ethnicity ▪ Deliver services without regard to race, gender, etc. ▪ Working with DPH Health Equity Council to help implement services to improve health equity in the state • Maternal Mortality and Morbidity <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Occurs during pregnancy or within a year after giving birth ○ Shifted to CDC recommendations ○ Will be coming out with recommendations for hospitals and patients on what can be approved ○ Birthing hospitals in Illinois <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Shifting levels of care to what systems should look like ▪ Align with AAP recommendations from 2012 	
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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do more community awareness/campaigns • Eight National Performance Measures <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Past year medical visits ○ Teeth cleaned during pregnancy <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Collaborate with DPH Division of Oral Health ▪ Prenatal or before tend to have better pregnancy outcomes ▪ Speak with cross-disciplinary group of stakeholders ○ Percentage of Medicaid enrolled women using most effective birth control method ○ Level 3 neonatal unit <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Hospitals less than Level 3 delivering babies ▪ Why patients were not transferred to hospitals with appropriate level of care ▪ Obtaining data on what is preventing women from going to correct hospital to deliver baby ○ Breastfeeding <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Percentage of infants being breastfed ○ Infants sleeping on backs <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Separate sleep surfaces ▪ Placed without soft blankets ○ Children receiving developmental screenings ○ Adolescents with previous medical visits within last year <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Creating adolescent medical services making them more adolescent friendly ▪ Making it easier for adolescents to transfer to adult care ▪ Coordinating with school health programs ○ Will have 12 new grantees working with local health departments 	
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Department of Public Health – Juana Ballesteros

- Internal Health Equity Council
 - Goal is to make sure as a state agency that we are supporting health equity
 - Fall – agency-wide equity self assessment
 - Develop an action plan to make sure it is in support of health equity and elimination of disparities

Department of Public Health – Heidi Clark

- FR-CARA Opioid Update
 - Naloxone soon to be distributed to 18 underserved counties
 - Since training was released, 78 police officers have completed the training
 - Police officers have online training through ILEAS
 - Funding could also include fire departments

Department of Public Health – Bill Dart

- Vital records is finishing up with statistics for 2017 birth and death records

Department of Insurance – Karen Woods

- Illinois was one of two states to submit a revised benchmark plan centered around opioids
 - Recommendations from medical community
 - Recommendation to cover alternative therapy for chronic pain, etc.
 - Evidence-based recommendations
 - Plan is submitted to be finalized
 - Press release on the Department’s website about the benchmark plan
- Expand substance and mental health care
- Continuing access of healthcare engagement tour
 - Held throughout the state
 - Meeting will advise if individuals are aware who to call if they have a question, claim that was denied, etc.
 - Focus is on outreach and education

State Board of Education – Jessica Gerdes

- Naloxone data report should be ready soon
- Co-chair of Suicide Prevention Alliance conference
- SAMHSA grant through the end of next June
 - Help children cope with mental health issues
 - Three districts: Decatur, Harrisburg, Aurora East
- Applied for Stop School Violence grant
 - Recognize mental health concerns

State Board of Health – Beth Fiorini

- HRSA has given out grants (SUD/MH grants) - noncompetitive
- Whiteside county to start telehealth and telepsych
- Sites increasing MAT program

Cook County Health Department – Kiran Joshi

- Health equity is key priority
- Agency wide yearlong training effort
- Asking all directors of units to integrate policies

DPH – Heidi Clark

- SHIP Annual Report
 - Incorporate data and updates on core indicators
 - Have most data
 - Some data is not available every year
 - Updates with state (do highlights)
 - Link on website to report
 - Draft available in the next couple weeks
