The **Grant Accountability and Transparency Act (GATA)** is landmark legislation that increases accountability and transparency and reduces the administrative burden on State agencies and grantees. The rules set forth under GATA will become effective on July 1, 2016. Over the next several months, potential applicants and grantees will be prepared for the effective date with trainings and resources provided by the Grant Accountability and Transparency Unit (GATU) housed at the Governor's Office of Management and Budget (GOMB), and the Illinois Department of Public Health.
