As you are now aware, the Grant Accountability and Transparency Act (GATA) is landmark legislation that will increase accountability and transparency in the use of grant funds while reducing the administrative burden on State agencies and grantees through the adoption of the federal grant guidance and regulations.

The Governor's Office of Management and Budget (GOMB) has announced the dates for two upcoming GATA training opportunities in May:

1. Budget Training for Grantees: Thursday, May 12 from 1:00pm-3:00pm **(Note: The EGrAMS budget has been updated for FY17 grants to accommodate the new, uniform budget template. This training is a general overview of the uniform template and requirements for all state of Illinois grantees (not just IDPH) and will vary from the electronic process that IDPH currently utilizes for the grant application phase.**
2. Applying Indirect Cost Rates to the Budget: Thursday, May 19 from 1:00pm-3:00pm

Please find attached the Save the Date notices for both trainings. Registration information/webinar links and supporting documents for the webinars have not been provided as yet, but will be distributed under a separate email as soon as IDPH receives them from GOMB. **Once again, webinar log-ins are extremely limited.** Group viewings are strongly encouraged to maximize participation.
