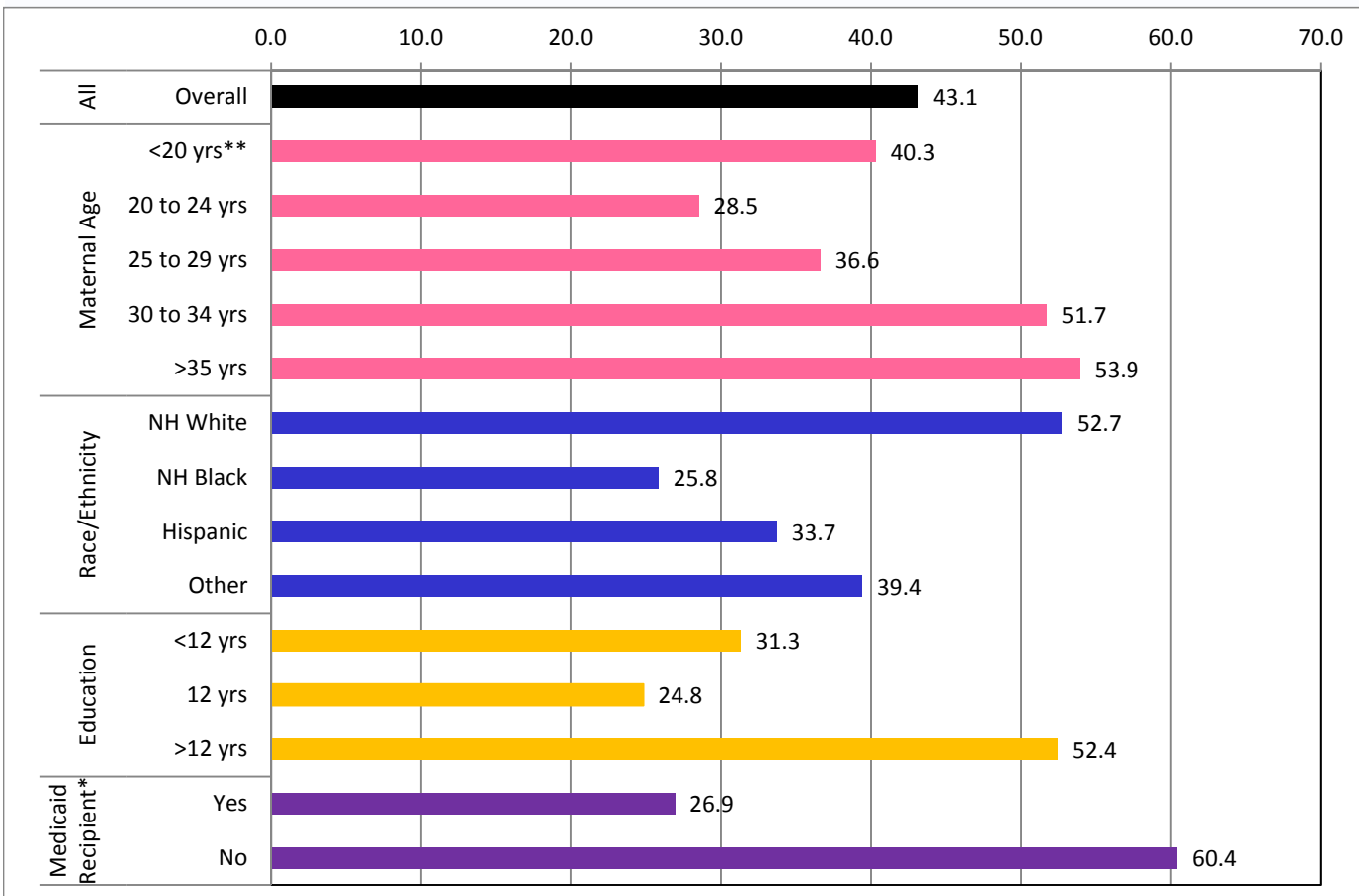


Prenatal Dental Care
