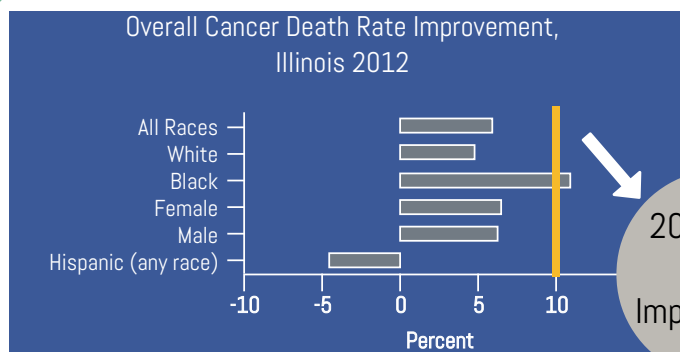

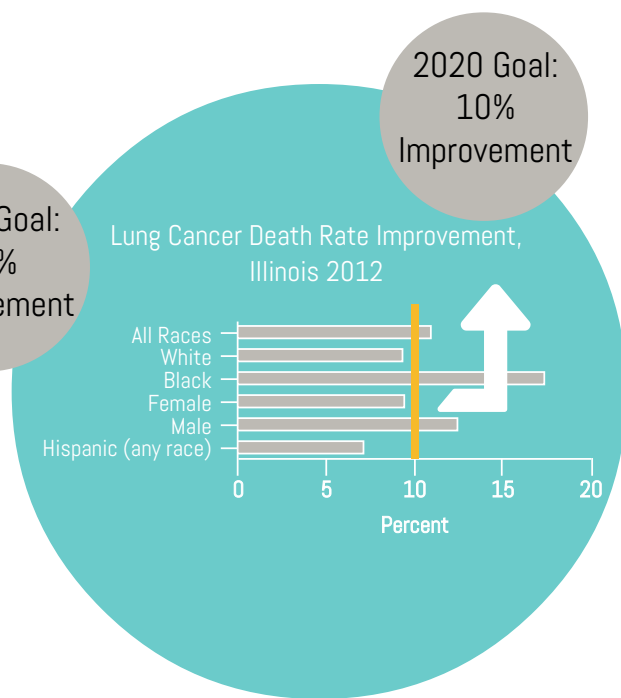
Illinois' Progress toward Selected Healthy People 2020 Objectives

## Reduce the Overall Cancer Death Rate



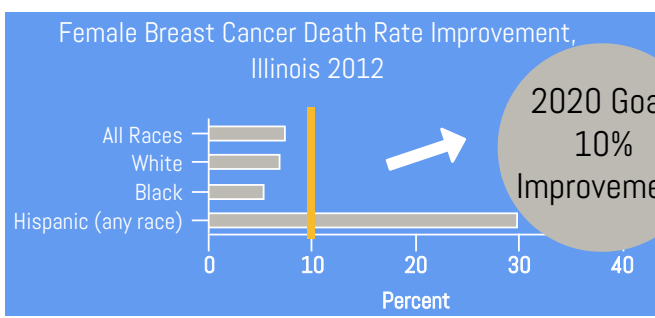
2020 Goal: 10% Improvement

## Reduce the Lung Cancer Death Rate



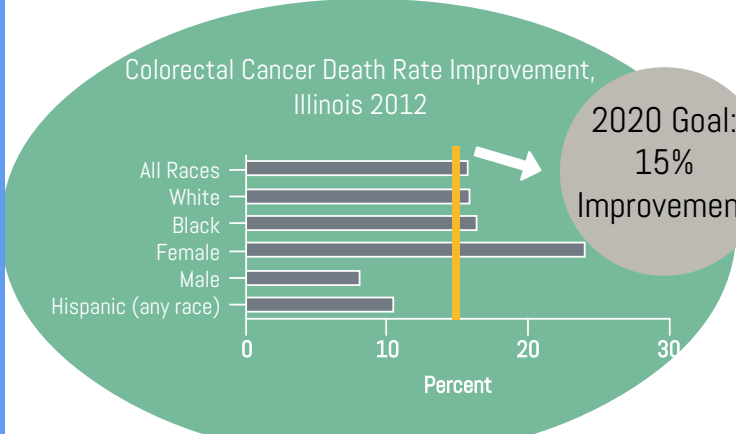
2020 Goal: 10% Improvement

## Reduce the Female Breast Cancer Death Rate



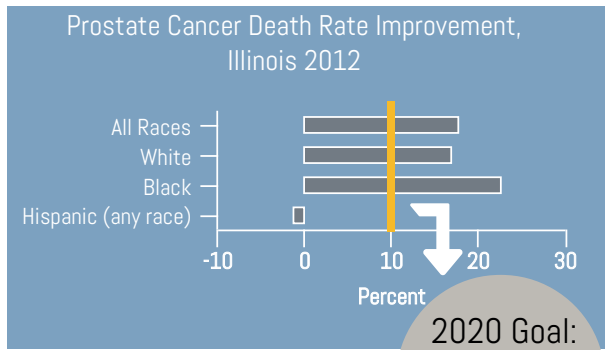
2020 Goal: 10% Improvement
