NHAS Goals:

- Goal 1: Reduce new HIV infections.
- Goal 2: Improve access to health care/ Improve health outcomes for PLWH.
- Goal 3: Reduce HIV-related health disparities.
- Goal 4: Achieve a more coordinated national response to the HIV epidemic.

Steps of the HIV Care Continuum:

- 1. Linkage to Care
- 2. Engagement in Care
- 3. Retention in Care
- 4. Antiretroviral Therapy
- 5. Viral Suppression
