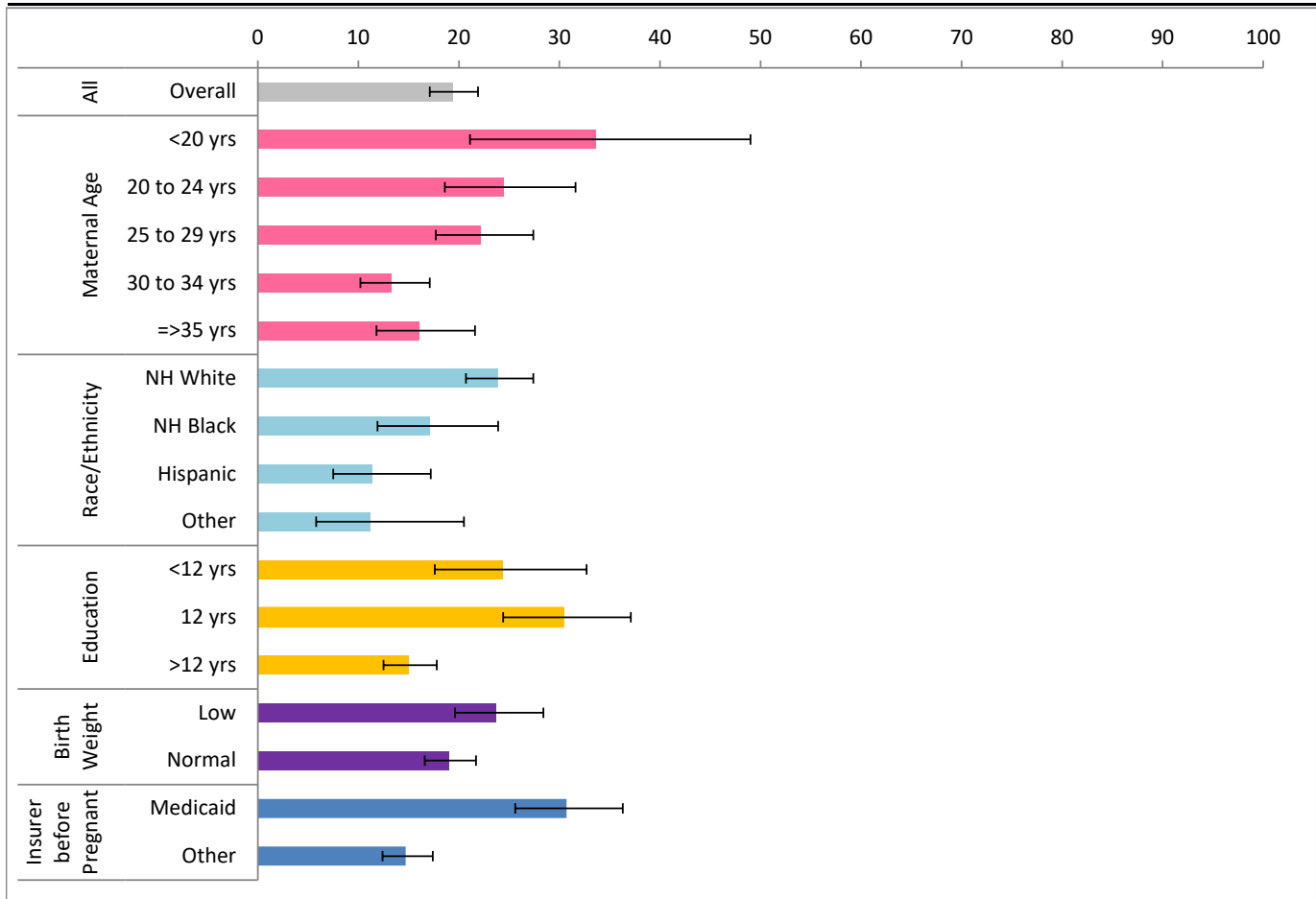


Smoking
