
Minority Health Disparities

Social and economic conditions contribute to gaps in health care and health outcomes between minorities and whites

Health disparities can arise from cultural barriers, language barriers, geographic isolation, and low income

Minorities experience a disproportionate burden of disease, disability, and death


Blacks ages 18-49 years, are **TWO times** as likely to die from heart disease than whites

Hispanics have a 23% higher obesity rate than whites


Blacks have the **HIGHEST**death rate for all cancers
combined compared with whites

American Indian/Alaska Native adults are **2.4 times** as likely as white adults to be diagnosed with diabetes
