Minutes

The minutes from April 2017 were approved.

Agenda Items

1. Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) Update

- Collaborative Improvement and Innovation Networks (CoIIN) – Risk Appropriate Care (RAC)
 - o Raye Ann de Regnier was at the meeting to give an update on the RAC CoIIN group.
 - o She wants the group's feedback on their project on risk appropriate care.
 - o Demographics for Inappropriate Care in Illinois of 2015:
 - Farther distance to a level III hospital
 - Medicaid insurance/self pay / other insurance
 - Inadequate/no prenatal care
 - Lower maternal education level
 - Younger maternal age
 - 22.4% of multiparous women delivering at non-level III hospital had prior preterm birth
 - o Strategies to Improve:
 - Provide Information - Slide Deck targeted to: IDPH website, OB/FP/Midwives, ER Physicians, and possibly expectant mothers.
 - Discussion of VPT review forms at M&M's
 - o Discussion around the committees' additional improvements and focusing on the goal of prevention.

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2. Illinois Perinatal Quality Collaborative (ILPQC) Update

- Ann Borders from the ILPQC covered their updates:
 - o Applied for their three year CDC grant. Will find out in July whether they get it or not.
 - o Submitting an application to the Pritzker foundation to support a post-partum LARC initiative.
 - o Additional Initiatives: Immediate post-partum LARC and optimizing vaginal birth. These were the two big outcomes from the feedback of the face-to-face meeting. They plan to start with the LARC project and then go to the vaginal birth initiative.
 - o Want to start putting a patient advisor on quality initiative teams at hospitals.
 - o Hypertension face-to-face meeting was in May. Worked on sustainability and culture change.
 - o Plan to continue the monthly team calls.
 - o Plan to give awards based on the level of completion and education.
 - o Golden Hour is the current initiative for their neonatal teams and focusing on four topics:
 - Delayed cord clamping
 - Temperatures of infants upon entrance to NICU
 - All communications measures
 - All family engagement measures
 - o The IDPH NAS Advisory Committee is aligning work with ILPQC's NAS quality improvement group.

4. New Business

Opioid Epidemic

- Stephen Locher went through a presentation on data on the opioid epidemic.

M&M Process and Quality

- Stephen Locher also spoke on the Mortality and Morbidity process and quality.
- Want to start looking at the trends from the MMRC group.
- Dr. Locher wants to create a subgroup that reports to the SQC focused on this topic.
