

PANDAS/PANS Advisory Council
August 22, 2017
Minutes

1. Call to order at 1:08 pm.
2. Approval of last meeting's minutes.
3. Committee reports
 - a. CME: Tiffany has put training videos on YouTube. Fees for CME presentations can potentially be collected for trainings or the council will be required to front \$100 per session. If the Council wants to develop its own training materials, it must seek approval of the new material by the company which issues the other training materials.
 - b. Annual Summit Committee: Grand Rounds in 2018 could take place of this for next year but it will be cost dependent.
 - c. Action Item committee: nothing to report
 - d. Communications: Formal Treatment Guidelines were published in the Journal of Child and Adolescent Psychopharmacology Aug 2017 issue.
 - i. Charlie's Law was signed by Gov. Rauner in mid-July, allowing for the insurance coverage for methods of treating PANDAS/PANS
 - ii. *Discussion took place regarding adding a link to the published JCAP guidelines, a link to Charlie's Law, and links to the YouTube training videos on the IDPH website. The council felt this was critical to our mission and should happen ASAP. Nick to follow through.
 - iii. Additionally, meeting minutes need to be uploaded to IDPH website for the past year. Nick also to follow through.
