 - Note: In 2013, there were approx 1 million ED visits for 0-15 y/o; 78.1% of these visits took place in a PCCC, EDAP or SEDP. Of the 1 million, approx 30,000 required admission with 94.4% of these admissions taking place in a PCCC, EDAP, or SEDP facility (Source: Illinois Hospital Assn Compdata)
