This individual independently performs detailed engineering surveys; assists in performing technical review, planning and directing the enforcement of laws and regulations to provide safe and sanitary conditions in accordance with applicable standards for General and Environmental Engineering Programs within the Division. This individual also serves as a lead worker.

The successful candidate will demonstrate knowledge, skill and mental development equivalent to completion of four years college with a bachelor's degree in engineering and coursework in sanitary, public health or environmental engineering, preferably from an ABET accredited university and will possess an Illinois Certificate as a Registered Professional Engineer.

Requirements for this position include completion four years of progressively responsible professional engineering experience in the field of environmental engineering, sanitary engineering or public health engineering and thorough knowledge of public and business administration, principals and practices. Requirements also include thorough knowledge of agency programs and service objectives, activities and operational systems and possession of a valid Illinois driver's license. Excellent computer skills and work experience in Microsoft software products including, Word, Excel, Power-point, etc. is highly desirable.
