MMRIA Review Form

- Amanda Bennett the CDC assignee from IDPH went over the MMRIA form from last meeting as a brief refresher
- Robin reminded everyone that this isn't a hospital review and is focused on population health
- Amanda also went over what was accomplished at the last meeting, the decisions summary.
- Went over committee decisions:
 - o If she had not been pregnant would she have died?
 - o Was the death preventable?
 - o What critical factors contributed to the death?
 - o What recommendations does the committee make to prevent future deaths
- Decision 6 Question: A decision to go back to the pre-review and say that it is missing information?
 - o A: The idea of the pre-review is to get to those questions prior to the final case being disseminated to the committee. If the committee still thinks things are missing than it will be going back to the cases and figuring out how to get that information from the hospitals
- Q: Interns that might map out resources in various communities? ie. social services, mental health
 - o A: That is still on the to-do list.
