Ship ICC Role Discussion	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Data for annual report should be tracked over time to encourage others to follow the progress. Keep same documents and update yearly.</li> <li>Some wanted to add legislative requirements and questioned if we will make progress without it. Will review current law to see if a requirement needs to be added.</li> <li>For priority areas, suggestion to meet with action teams with co-chairs for each group. They were very involved in planning council.</li> <li>Look at what other ICCs from other states are doing. See how SHIP can be utilized going forward. Make sure state agencies are involved and engaged.</li> <li>ICC would like Director Shah's input and would like an individual from HFS on agenda for the next meeting.</li> </ul>	T. Hughes volunteered to draft legislative mandate for annual report if needed.

<p>Reports on Activities Aligning with SHIP</p>	<p><b><u>Reports</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Discussed mental health, aligning with HHS goals, 1115 waiver: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Original target date: July 1. There was a delay due to the change in administration. If waiver is approved, we do not know when that might happen.</li> <li>○ Waiver advisory council originally planned to meet every two weeks. They still meet, but not as frequently as planned. There are approximately 30 individuals in the group.</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p><b><u>Family-to-Family Health Information Center</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Staffed by family members of people with special healthcare needs. Any diagnosis up to age 21. Would like consumers to have input on what impacts them. Unmet need: MH needs for publicly-insured children.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>IDPH Div. of Health Data and Policy</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Opioid updates <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Opioid OD – Semi-annual report submitted in June</li> <li>○ State strategic plan with data report to be released in August</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p>Q: What happens to babies with NAS and if they are referred anywhere?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ High-risk infant follow-up programs at local health departments</li> </ul> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <b><u>IDPH – Office of Women’s Health and Family Services:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Rule change, levels of care, align Illinois levels of care with recommendations with AAP</li> <li>○ Severe maternal morbidity, what are the trends, issues, etc. in order to improve outcomes for women</li> <li>○ Implementing quality improvement</li> <li>○ Illinois Perinatal Quality Collaborative - look at systems alignment</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p><b><u>DHS Division of Mental Health</u></b></p> <p>Looking into change in data collection within Division of Mental Health – related specifically to services that are publicly-funded. Change focus in paying for volume of services vs paying for outcomes. Applied for a couple of grants – states to apply with community providers.</p> <p>Develop center for excellence in integration:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Reduced deaths due to BH crisis, SAMHSA grant opportunities, youth suicides</li> </ul>	<p>H. Clark will check that semi-annual opioid report is posted on website</p>
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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Increased scope of grant, don't know if will get it. Learn by writing grant applications</li> <li>● Integrated health home. Expand license provider types (now, psychiatrist, later psychologist, etc.). Blue Island at capacity within two months.</li> </ul>
